

SUBJECT: Bill-Signing Ceremonies

The following procedure is to be followed regarding Bill-Signing Ceremonies:

A. If someone on the White House staff, whether it be Congressional, Domestic, Political or Public Relations, wishes to have a signing ceremony, their recommendations should be forwarded to John Nidecker outlining:

- the bill to be signed
- the type of signing ceremony requested
 - public or private (during the Congressional Half Hour)
- the reasons for a ceremony, and
- a proposed list of invitees (both Congressional and non-Congressional).

A carbon copy of the recommendation to John Nidecker should be forwarded to Dwight Chapin to alert his staff of a possible ceremony.

- B. John Nidecker, after adequate consultation with the Congressional, Domestic, Political and Public Relations staffs, will prepare a memorandum for Bill Timmons outlining the "pros" and "cons" of the ceremony with a proposed list of attendees. Proposed Congressional attendees should be cleared with the Domestic staff. Non-Congressional attendees should be cleared by the Congressional staff.
- C. If favorable, Bill Timmons will then make a formal recommendation to Dwight Chapin. Dwight will then get an approval or disapproval.
- D. If the President approves the signing ceremony, Dwight Chapin will inform the Domestic (Cole), the Congressional (Nidecker), the Political (Dent), and the Public Relations (Magruder) staffs.
- E. The Congressional staff will invite Congressional attendees. Any non-Congressional attendees approved by Chapin will be invited by the appropriate Domestic Assistant. John Nidecker ~~is to forward a list of Congressional acceptances and regrets~~ to Steve Bull who will write up a scenario for the President's use. A final list of non-Congressional attendees should also be forwarded to Steve Bull.
- F. If the bill to be signed is domestic in nature, the appropriate Domestic Assistant is to prepare specific, substantive talking points for the President's use. Mr. Keogh's staff will not be involved in the preparation of these talking points. Each ceremony will have talking points, which should be forwarded to Steve Bull for inclusion with the scenario.
- G. Both the final lists of attendees and the talking points are to be forwarded to Steve Bull 24 hours in advance of the ceremony.
- H. Steve Bull's office will take care of the appropriate clearances for invited guests.
- I. The Congressional staff (Nidecker) will review daily the list of bills received at the White House for possible signing ceremony opportunities. Should any questions exist, Nidecker will be in contact with the appropriate domestic, Congressional, political and public relations people for their recommendations.

MEMORANDUM FOR JOHN EHRLICHMAN

Subject: White House Staff Requests on Domestic Programs

As part of our effort to plan for next year's budget, we have been reviewing our structure and processes to see how they can be made more effective. One area of concern is to ensure that our staff responds adequately to requests from White House staff.

All Bureau staff are on standing notice to respond promptly and fully, consistent with their other responsibilities to me (and also, therefore, reflective of Presidential requirements). I think, however, it would be helpful to you and to us if requests could be channeled through principal responsible officers -- specifically the office and division directors -- rather than to individual staff members.


This would ensure that the right Bureau staff are working on a request, that the response is adequately coordinated within the Bureau, and that the political officers of the Bureau are involved at appropriate times and occasions.

I have designated certain Bureau staff as major points of contact. Their names are set forth in the attachment, with their specific agency responsibilities where applicable. I appreciate this list being made available to individual White House staff members. In those cases in which requests are improperly directed, I have asked Bureau staff to put them back into the right channels.

There have been a number of occasions in which pressures of time have led to a desire to telescope the normal review procedures. In the nature of things, exceptional treatment cannot be regularly provided on the majority of issues. Therefore, whenever it is desired to have compression of authorized procedures, we would like to have a direct request from you or one of your top deputies.

With respect to the time allowed for Budget Bureau review, the Bureau's recommendations very often are based not only upon whatever expertise may be available within the Bureau itself but also upon the Bureau's ability to obtain, analyze, and draw conclusions from the views of interested agencies. When time pressures are too great to allow for this synthesis, the President is deprived of a staff resource which should be, and is, available to him.

One further thought. Regretably, a number of agencies try from time to time to evade the usual review procedures by pleading a White House deadline or an urgent congressional request. In order best to serve the President, we have to guard against these attempts. I am sure that I will have your cooperation in meeting this problem.
